CAPITAL ORDINANCE NO. 08-2024

CAPITAL ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF HAMPTON, IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, STATE OF NEW JERSEY, AUTHORIZING THE MAKING OF PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS IN, BY AND FOR THE BOROUGH OF HAMPTON AND APPROPRIATING THEREFOR THE SUM OF \$146,000.00 FROM THE ARPA GRANT AND THE WATER CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT FUND OF THE BOROUGH.

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Borough Council of the Borough of Hampton, in the County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. The Borough of Hampton in the County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey, is hereby authorized to make the following public improvements in, by and for the Borough, including all work, materials and appurtenances necessary and suitable therefore:

Equipment Trailer	\$ 6,750.00
Mini Excavator	\$ 81,000.00

Section 2. The aggregate sum of \$146,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the ARPA Grant (\$137,953.12) and Water Capital Improvement Fund (\$8,046.88) of the Borough of Hampton to the payment of the cost of the improvements as described in Section 1 hereof.

Section 3. Said improvements are lawful capital improvements of the Borough having a period of usefulness of at least five (5) years. Said improvements shall be made as general improvements, no part of the cost of which shall be assessed against property specially benefited.

Section 4. The water capital budget of the Borough of Hampton is hereby amended to conform with provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith. The resolution in the form promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing full detail of the amended capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director of the Division of Local Government Services is on file with the Clerk and is available there for public inspection.

Section 5. This capital ordinance shall take effect after final passage and publication as required by law.
