BOND ORDINANCE STATEMENT AND SUMMARY

The bond ordinance, the summary terms of which are included herein, has been finally adopted by the Borough of Hampton, in the County of Hunterdon, State of New Jersey on August 21, 2023 and the 20 day period of limitation within which a suit, action or proceeding questioning the validity of such bond ordinance can be commenced, as provided in the Local Bond Law, has begun to run from the date of the first publication of this statement. Copies of the full bond ordinance are available at no cost and during regular business hours at the Clerk's office for members of the general public who request the same. The summary of the terms of such bond ordinance follows:

Title: BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING A SUPPLEMENTAL APPROPRIATION OF \$125,000 FOR THE FOSS AVENUE PROJECT IN AND BY THE BOROUGH OF HAMPTON, IN THE COUNTY OF HUNTERDON, NEW JERSEY, AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$125,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE BOROUGH TO FINANCE THE COST THEREOF

Purpose: The Foss Avenue Project, including all work and materials necessary therefor and incidental thereto, as described in Bond Ordinance #08-2022, finally adopted September 19, 2022

Supplemental Appropriation: \$125,000

Supplemental Bonds/Notes Authorized: \$125,000

Grant Appropriated: N/A

Supplemental Section 20 Costs: \$25,000

Useful Life: 10 years
